

NOTICE OF POTENTIAL INELIGIBILITY

Mikell T. Wright – 225 NE 612 St, Old Town, FL 32680

You are potentially ineligible to register to vote. After this published date, you will have thirty days to respond to determine your eligibility by the supervisor. This could result in the removal of your name from the statewide voter registration system. If you deny the accuracy of your potential ineligibility, you have the right to a hearing for the purpose of determining eligibility.

If you attempt to vote at an early voting site or your normal election day polling place, you will be required to vote a provisional ballot. If you vote by mail, your ballot will be treated as a provisional ballot. In either case, your ballot may not be counted until a final determination of eligibility is made. If you wish for your ballot to be counted, you must contact the supervisor of elections office within 2 days after the election and present evidence that you are eligible to vote. Per F.S. 98.075(5) & (7)
